Promoting renewable energy projects in Salisbury

What they do:

Salisbury Community Energy Ltd (SCE) is a not-for-profit Community Benefit Society that was set up in 2017. It aims to drive the uptake of local renewable energy as part of the effort to limit climate change.

SCE rolls out free installation of large-scale PV projects, funded by investments that offer generous dividends to shareholders.

In partnership with Schools Energy Co-op, SCE has installed solar panels on five sites in the city, including the cathedral and places of education, generating over 417,000 kilowatt hours of energy to date. Commercial buildings where demand is high are also good propositions.

SCE's work to date has reduced Salisbury's emissions by 97 tonnes.
